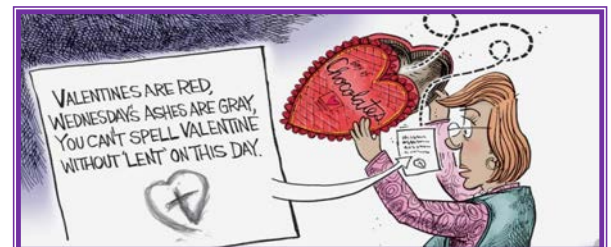


World Day of the Sick:

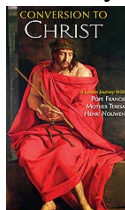
