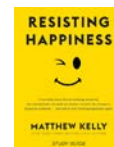

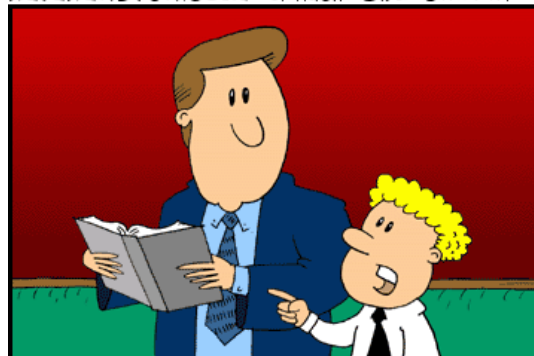
Youth Committee Meeting:
