### **What is the cost involved for active parishioners?**

Members of Holy Cross, Cuba; St. Michael, Steelville; and St. Francis, Bourbon may send their child to Holy Cross Catholic School by regularly and appropriately contributing to the parish offertory. No child from any of these parishes will be denied enrollment because of financial constraint. All students pay an annual school fee of \$250.00 per student PreK-8.

### **What is the cost involved for non-parishioners?**

The yearly tuition is \$2,500.00 per family. You may elect to pay this on a monthly, quarterly basis, a semi-annual basis, or in advance. The first payment is due at the time of registration. All students pay a school fee of \$250.00 per student PreK-8.

### **How do I register my child?**

Children must be potty trained, 4 years old by July 31 to enroll in pre-K or 5 years old by July 31 to enroll in kindergarten. You will need the following to register your child: Birth certificate, Immunization record (child must be up-to-date on immunizations to enter school), Baptismal Certificate (if baptized elsewhere), or Baptismal date if baptized at Holy Cross.
